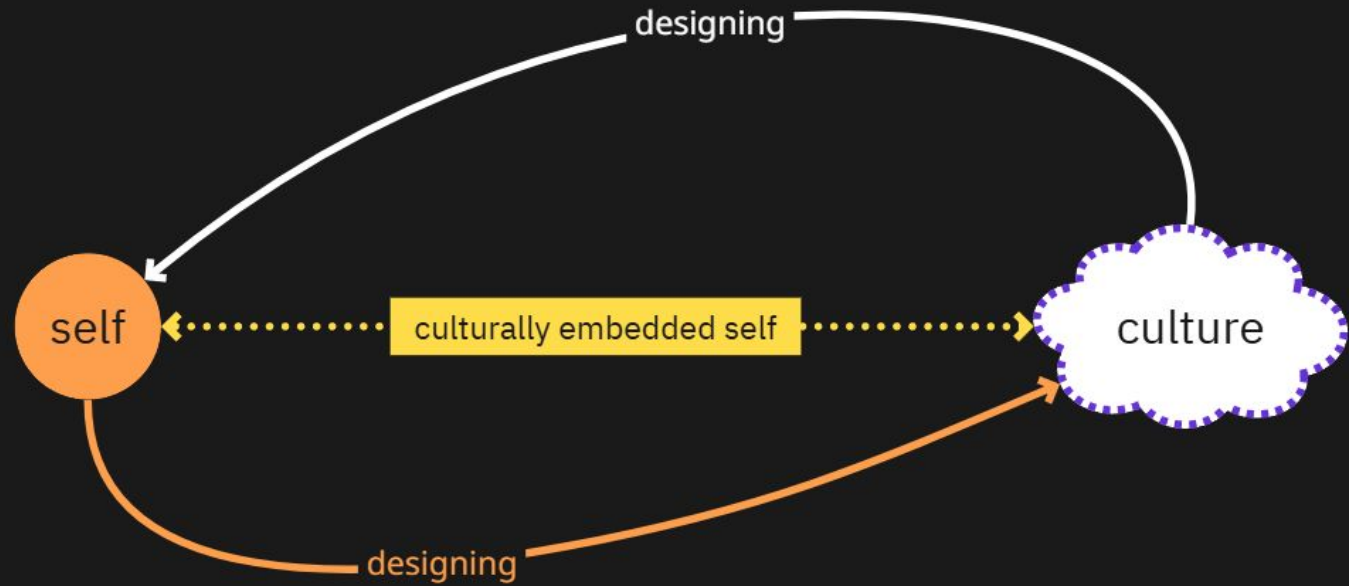

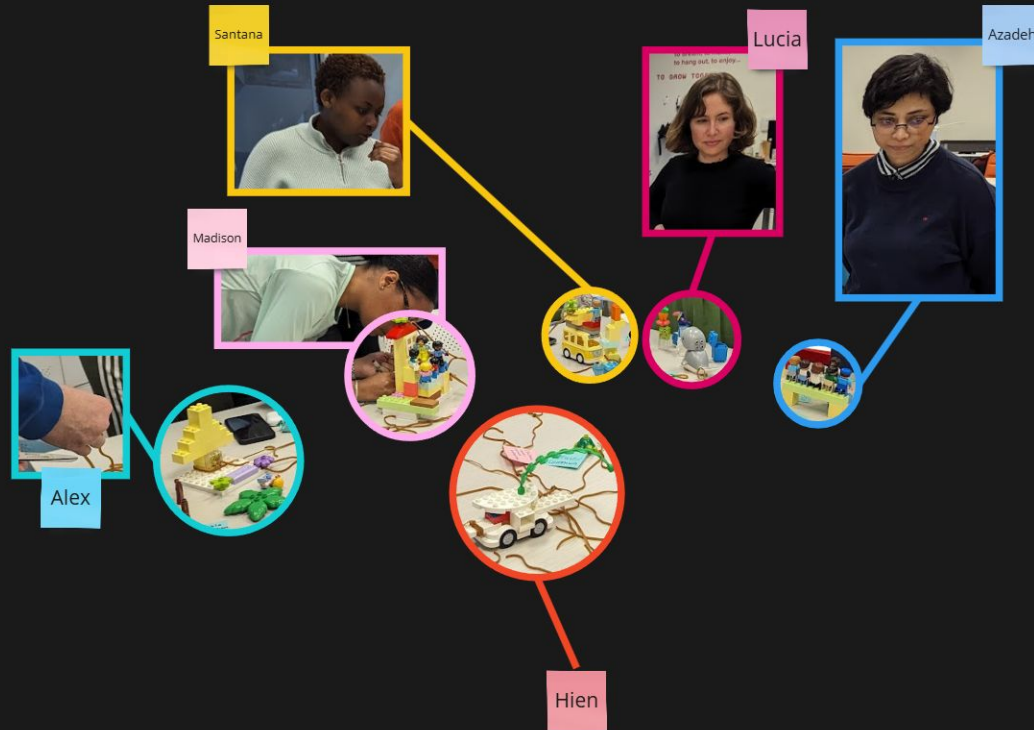

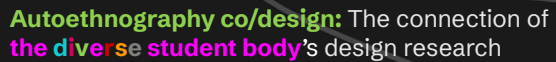

Low-tech, metaphorical codesign toolkits, such as Lego Serious Play animals, color labels, and the South-up world map

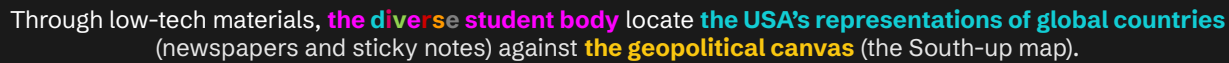

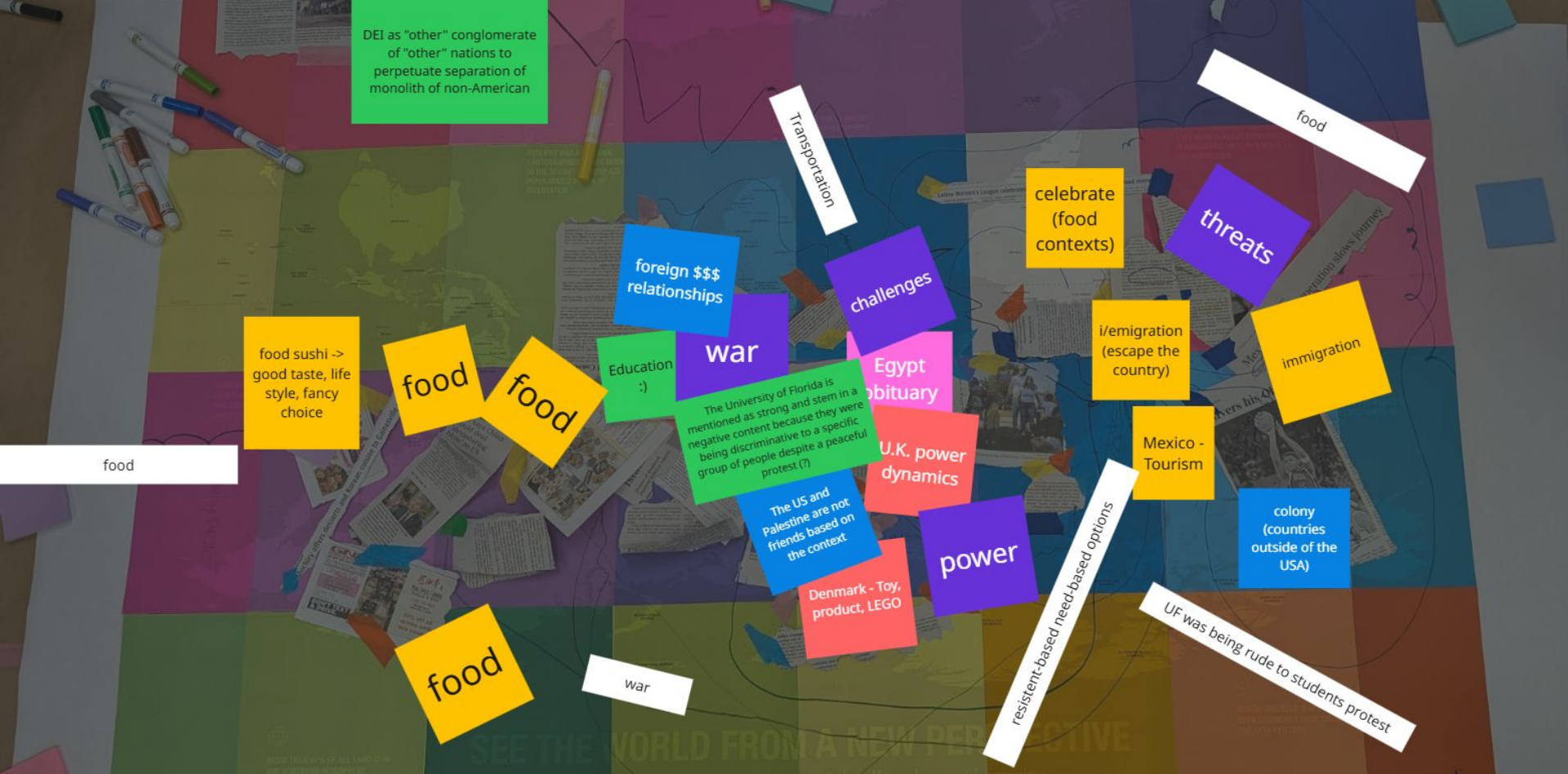
Through **autoethnographic co/design**,

Through the authors' data digitization, the **USA's representations of global countries** (colored squares) and **geopolitical connections** (white rectangles) are color coded.

I started thinking about *what kind of stereotypes about Russians that I felt in the US*. Even my kid, he already joined schools where he is differently [...] as a Russian spy.

a Russian-American female

(Florida) can push designer like me to *the present simplified or certain version of our culture*.

an Iranian female immigrant

Design research findings

Through **autoethnographic co/design**, **institutional diversity** is critiqued for its superficial inclusivity, stereotypical misrepresentation, and perpetuated oppression in **the USA neoliberal multiculturalism**.

Design research findings

Through **autoethnographic co/design**, **the diverse student body** was decolonizing the colonialist, racist, and oppressive institution through low-tech materials and dialogues.
